 - Skate park would be ideal. Plus toilets available.
 - Parkour new basketball area. More benches for parents to sit on as many of us have to stand each day.
 - Definitely needs more seating areas, 2 benches just isn't enough for the park, more seating/tables to be placed in the play area so your able to keep and eye on your children
 - Skatepark would be great for the teenagers
 - Skate park, bike ramp tracks would be great for older children get them out of the house using bikes, scooters or skateboards
 - anything that may get people out is good
 - More seating for parents
 - new BMX/bike course, skate park, bigger and better built basketball court !
 - I think the play area is an amazing addition to the village. My children are 7 and 9 years old and use the equipment regularly. The one issue we feel is with the zip wire, the ramp is very slippery (in dry weather) with no grips and there have been a few incidents already involving my children and others falling over, so I feel this could be improved.
 - they look great
 - Add a 3g pitch for football
 - It's very good thinking long term would be good to have lights around the sides
 - There used to be bike ramps years ago made of soil over the other side where the trees are for the teenagers that have now gone.
 - Good range for younger children but more needed for older children
 - All done very nicely. Should be a little bigger to separate the age ranges. Otherwise you find the bigger kids play on the smaller ages equipment
 - More baby friendly equipment and possibly better seating
