The Charities Objects

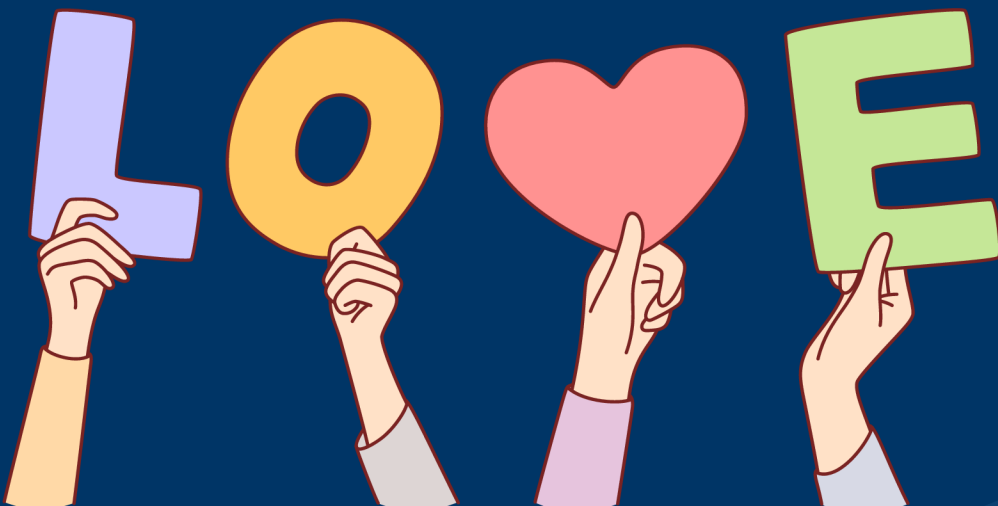
1. To raise funds for community activities and facilities in the area of Clenchwarton and surrounding villages.

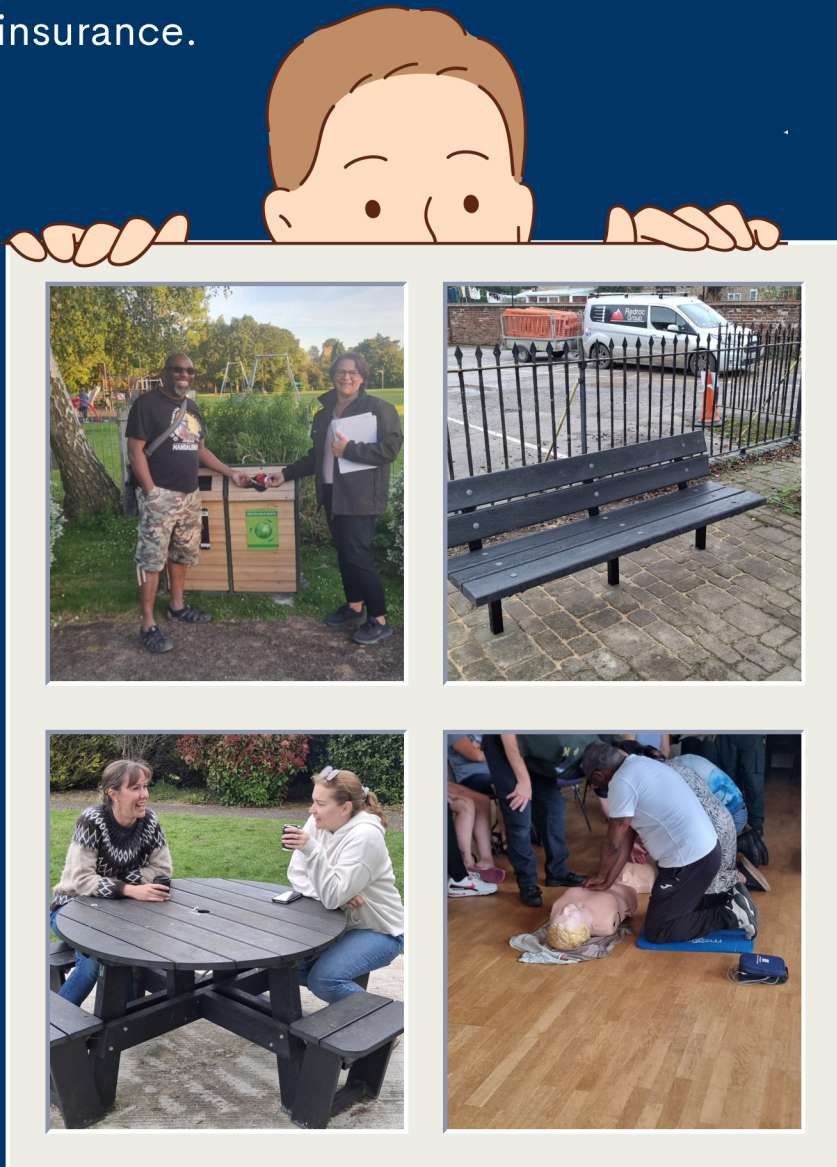


Our Work So Far...

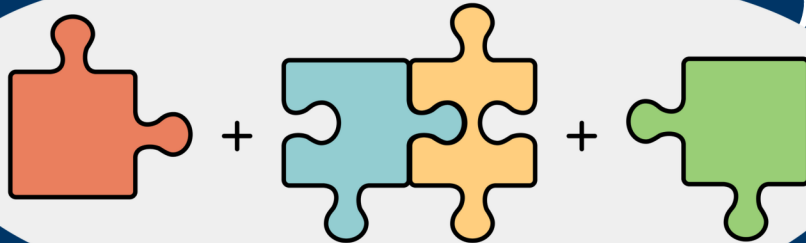

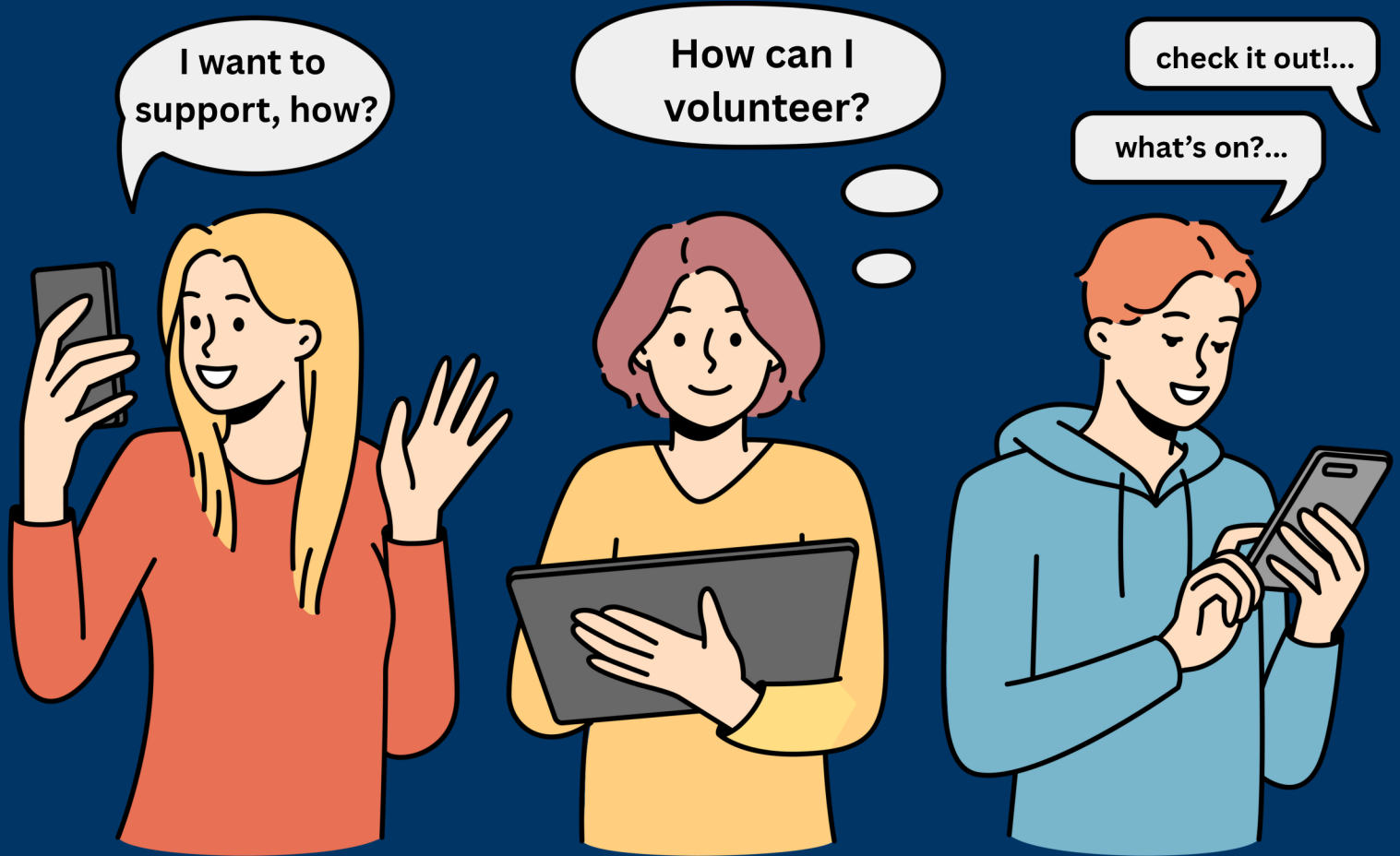
